

Acts Part 29

Acts 15:1

Some men came down from Judea and began to teach the brothers, "Unless you are circumcised according to the custom prescribed by Moses, you cannot be saved."

- I. Outside negative influence is always on the way (v.1)
- Gospel + anything else = heresy
 - Men came from OUTSIDE the church to bring "truth"
 - Gospel + circumcision = salvation (NOT TRUE)

GOSPEL + NOTHING = GOSPEL

1 John 4:9-10

In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

- God sent His son
- We live ONLY through Jesus
- Not through OUR love for God, but HIS love for us (salvific)
- Jesus is PROPITIATION for our sin
- Jesus than expiates our sin

salvation has everything to do with Jesus, and nothing to do with your actions. Jesus saves, not you.

- Gospel + no more struggle of sin
- Gospel + speaking in tongues
- Gospel + no alcohol
- Gospel + proper hair and clothing
- Gospel + just Christian music (no music is Christian...)
